August General Membership Meeting Minutes

August 17th, 2013

President's Report – Larry Main

Larry received an additional bid for the new shed for the club from Sherman Lumber:

48' x 26' – 4 stalls \$12,392.00 (includes material & labor) (no doors)
(add 2 doors in the back \$2,562.00)

This is in addition to the bids received from Menard's (\$10,118) and Arrow (\$27,772) that were published in last month's newsletter.

The voting for the new shed was held over to next month to review with club Treasurer, Paul Kipping, to go over options available to the club to purchase the shed

There were 160 tickets sold for the July Calendar daily raffle which equated to \$3,200 and are paying out \$3,500.

Next month the club will be reviewing inputting signs at each boat launch to remind boaters to remove weeds, etc. sponsored by the Lakes & Pines Sno-Trail club. The options brought up were 3 individual signs or one large sign and cost for the signs depends on the size. It was brought up that there was a possibility of lowering the cost by going through the DNR – George Kuechle will check into this.

The monorail in Minneapolis, MN has banners available for advertisement on the train. The cost is \$3,700 per banner; each banner has 10 spots available. You must purchase one banner, so we would open this up to businesses to participate at \$370 per spot to advertise on the monorail.
