President's Report – Larry Main

The next county meeting is Tuesday, August 26th. Larry will provide a list of the business members that have paid their memberships to get them on the county snowmobile maps.

Larry received the grooming contract from the county. He will sign and bring to the county board meeting.

With the new trail pass law that is to go into effect the year of 2015, there has been questions as to how to obtain the trail pass. Presently the process is to pay for the trail pass, than the information is sent to AWSC to verify club membership for the discounted price, once confirmed then the trail pass is sent to the member. This is critical that our club membership is continually updated and forwarded to the AWSC for this current process.

For the trail (South of 77) we have a 1 mile commitment to clear brush and will require some dozer work, on the north side of the road. George made motion: To send a letter to the township committing to them to maintain north side right-of-way for the snowmobile trail. 2nd by Paul, motion carried. With moving this trail off the road there may be a possibility in the near future that we could obtain funding.

Larry is providing a snowmobile for a raffle that will be at the Fish Bowl with the proceeds going to Lakes & Pines Sno-Trails club. **Grand Prize: 2014 Ski-Doo 600 or \$5,000.00 cash**

Buck made a motion to allow Larry to use the raffle license for this snowmobile giveaway. 2nd by: George, motion carried.

Vice President's Report – George Kuechle

George presented a bill for the repair of the soft flooring in the maintenance building.

George was approached by Todd @ Polk-Burnett about possibly putting a 45,000 gallon propane tank (80' in length) on club property. George, Dave and Todd will meet to discuss location and come back to the club with recommendation (if any).

Treasurer's Report – Paul Kipping

There were 13 business members that have paid their dues early which entitled them to a \$25 discount from the annual membership dues (\$250). Of those 13 paid memberships, three of the businesses paid the full membership dues and therefore will be receiving a \$25 refund for paying early.

Any business that pays membership **dues AFTER August 15th** will incur a ***\$25 late charge***, which makes the membership **dues \$275**.

Any business that pays membership **dues AFTER September 1st** ***will NOT be on the maps***.

Paul made a motion to have Rich Danielson to be the club representative to handle all insurance responsibilities and report back to Paul, 2nd by George, motion carried. Rich will obtain serial numbers of the club property and ensure that the club has the appropriate equipment insured.
