WI TRAIL PASS – IT'S TIME

A \$10 discounted annual Wisconsin trail pass will be available to people who currently belong to both a Wisconsin snowmobile club (like ours) and the AWSC. The discounted pass will be available for each of your **Wisconsin-registered snowmobiles**. The snowmobile clubs continue to be responsible for collecting your AWSC membership dues.

The Wisconsin trail pass is \$30 for snowmobilers who are NOT members of a snowmobile club and the Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs (AWSC). This pass may be ordered online through the DNR or purchased at any DNR license sales agent.

Note that your Lakes & Pines Sno-Trails AWSC membership ID is on your yellow membership card. It is also on the mailing label of the AWSC magazine that you receive if you are a member.
