Burnett County has signed the state agreement to re-route off of Trail 8 leading to the Cassie Loop to be widened and resurfaced to become a summer ATV trail as well.

Trail 41N off Norman’s Landing will have a culvert installed and Sue is aware this needs to be completed.

The Cranberry Marsh is also getting a new culver and repairs on the existing culvert.

We also have to patch and put in a cross-over culvert by Rainbow Bay. Buck and Mark are working to see if we can put in rock (class 5) and widen the trail also (for grooming purposes)

Buck is working with the current landowners to re-route the access to Fish Lake from Kessler Road.

Buck is receiving more complaints and requests for gates due to ATV issues on snowmobile trails that cross privately owned land that we have a trail(s) through/on. ATV’s are becoming more of an issue with private landowners in recent months.

Buck is looking into the winch to see if there is an update on the repair or the sending out for repair to a business in Iowa.
