A REMINDER: Everyone must buy a trail pass every year. Wisconsin snowmobile trail pass for club members (\$10)-For a snowmobile registered in Wisconsin and owned by a person who is both a member of a snowmobile club and a member of AWSC. Non-AWSC members trail passes are \$30.

The membership process takes place by mail and may take up to six weeks so join early. Once the membership is completed, passes may be ordered through the AWSC website or their office.
